DAY 1-2 | NAIROBI, KENYA

Arrive Nairobi and settle into your stylish accommodation on the edge of Nairobi's leafy suburbs.

DAY 2-5 | MASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE, KENYA

It is a wonder to see the red-robed Maasai coexisting with the large game of Africa. The Masai Mara offers a wide array of camps and lodges, ranging from colonial "Out of Africa" style to modern Maasai. Hot air balloons soar into the vast skies above this tribal land, and the Big Five is a game drive away.

DAY 5-6 | NAIROBI, KENYA

Return to Nairobi after a morning game viewing. This afternoon enjoy optional tours including visiting rescued orphaned elephants and rhinos.

DAY 6-8 | LIVINGSTONE, ZAMBIA

One of the world's largest waterfalls can be seen from the unique vantage point of Devil's Pool, right on the edge of Victoria Falls. This is a bucket-list must-see and does not disappoint! Don a poncho in April and May and walk out to the middle of the suspended bridge for a full view of the 'smoke that thunders.' Sunset cruises take you close to the curtain of the falls, where you can feel the strength of the water pounding into the earth below.

DAY 8-11 | OKAVANGO DELTA, BOTSWANA

The Okavango is a water wonderland with a range of habitats. Lodges perch over swirling pools where hippos and croc glide. Incomparable game viewing abounds from the boat, mokoro canoe, 4X4, on foot, or aerial light aircraft.

DAY 11-14 | CAPE TOWN, SOUTH AFRICA

Bright, sunny weather, long sandy beaches, and the convergence of two huge oceans all await you here in the elegant, historic city of Cape Town. This bustling harbor town is anchored by the world-famous Table Mountain, made up of almost erosion-proof quartzitic sandstone. There is so much to enjoy in this historic town.
