DAY 1-2 | NAIROBI, KENYA

Historic Nairobi is definitely worth more than just a night. Visit orphaned elephants and rhinos rescued by the Sheldrick Wildlife Trust. Hand-feed a giraffe at The Giraffe Center. And you shouldn't miss the Karen Blixen Museum or the African curio markets!

DAY 2-5 | AMBOSELI NATIONAL PARK, KENYA

How would you like to wake up to a view of Mt Kilimanjaro with a foraging bull elephant in the foreground? Walking safaris, night game drives, and interaction with local Maasai communities make for an irresistible combination in this coveted national park. Your tented camp lies on a large private reserve, adjacent to Amboseli National Park allowing for these spectacular opportunities.


DAY 5-8 | MOUNT KENYA & LAIKIPIA, KENYA

Horseback or camel rides anyone? With more than 2 million acres of private ranches, the Laikipia plateau stretches from Mt Kenya to the Rift Valley and allows plenty of breathing room between game drivers. This ancient migratory corridor offers fine game viewing and the opportunity to see the rarer species such as wild dog, reticulated giraffe and Grevy's zebra. Incredible lodges offer activities with local Samburu guides. Your own private Africa!

DAY 8-11 | MASAI MARA, KENYA

It is a wonder to see first-hand the red-robed Maasai coexisting with the large game of Africa. The Masai Mara offers a wide array of camps and lodges, ranging from colonial "Out of Africa" style to modern Maasai. Hot air balloons soar into the vast skies above this tribal land, and from July to September, you will witness thousands of animals migrating from the Serengeti. The Big Five is almost always a game drive away.
